COUNSELLING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSION TO BVSc & AH DEGREE PROGRAMME 2022-23

1. The candidate should appear **IN PERSON** for Counselling.
2. The candidate should report at the Counselling venue **one hour before** the stipulated time mentioned in the Counselling call letter on the specified date.
3. The candidate should register himself / herself for the Counselling within the stipulated time. They need to be present in the Counselling hall and respond when their names are read out / called, failing which they will lose their chance of being selected.
4. **Mere calling for counselling does not offer any guarantee for admission to BVSc & AH degree programme.**
5. The candidates who have been called for the Counselling will be selected on the basis of the aggregate (cut off) marks obtained by them (as mentioned in the Prospectus) and also on the basis of the vacancy position available at the constituent colleges of the University following the community reservation rules of Tamil Nadu Government.
6. The candidate is also requested to bring the following original documents for the Counselling:
 - i. Call letter for counselling
 - ii. HSC / Equivalent Course mark sheet
 - iii. 11th Std. mark sheet (for those who have passed 12th Std. in Tamil Nadu State Board from the year 2019)
 - iv. Nativity certificate (if applicable)
 - v. Community certificate (obtained from the competent Revenue authority).
 - vi. Transfer certificate
 - vii. Conduct certificate
 - viii. Relevant certificates for special categories (Differently abled / Sports Certificates as prescribed in the prospectus (if applicable)
 - ix. First graduate certificate (if applicable)
 - x. Income certificate if the annual income is less than Rs.2.50 lakh
 - xi. Bonafide Certificate / evidence for having joined in other course (if applicable)
 - xii. One set of **Xerox copies** with all relevant certificates along with Application Form
7. If the candidate has already joined in any other course, the candidate is advised **not to obtain Transfer and Conduct Certificates** from the Institution in which he / she is studying, as the Counselling in this University does not offer any guarantee for selection. Hence, the evidence for having joined in other courses should be produced at the time of Counselling.
8. The selected candidate shall pay the following fees at the time of admission, provided he / she has all the original certificates:
