Counseling

Important:

- i) The candidate should bring with them all the requisite original Certificates / documents for verification at the time of counseling.
- ii) The attested copies of the certificates or similar other documents will not be entertained for granting admission to a candidate to the MBBS/BDS/BHMS course.
- List of provisionally eligible candidates according to their rank/merit in NEET (UG)-2023 and category will be displayed on Website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.
- 2. Final eligibility for admission against various categories will be determined after scrutiny of original documents at the time of counseling.
- 3. All eligible candidates including own merit candidates from reserved categories (except PwD/Foreign Indian Student /International/NRI category candidates), will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list, in addition to the category/categories they have applied for.
- 4. Candidate(s) belonging to a reserved category who fulfills all the criteria for general category (own merit candidates) and on the basis of his/her rank/merit in the NEET (UG)-2023 obtains admission in general category shall not be counted towards the seats earmarked for the reserved category concerned.
- 5. It is further clarified that SC candidate(s) who obtain admission in the general category on the basis of his/her rank/merit will continue to get all the benefits such as fee concession etc. available to SC candidates admitted against seats reserved for Scheduled Castes.
- 6. **Personal appearance** of candidate before the Counseling/Admission Committee is **mandatory** for claiming seat as per rank/merit determined and displayed.
- 7. Mere attending the counseling for a course does not confer any right to admission in that course. Admission will be strictly according to the rank/merit in NEET (UG)-2023.
- 8. Sequence of counseling will be for General Category seats first, followed by reserved category seats.
- 9. If an eligible candidate reports late for counseling when his/her turn according to his/her rank/merit has already been passed over, he/she will be considered as per available seat at the time of his/her actual reporting in the counseling.

- 10. A candidate once granted admission cannot re-appear in subsequent counseling for the same course.
- **11.** An otherwise eligible candidate who did not appear in the first counseling is allowed to appear in the second or subsequent counseling and will be offered the available course/seat as per his/her rank/merit in that counseling.
- **12.** The second counseling will be conducted for the vacant seats, if any.
- **13.** In case of any seat remaining unfilled in any reserved category due to non-availability of an eligible candidate, the same will be de-reserved and filled from amongst general category candidates as per merit/rank in NEET (UG)-**2023**.
- 14. No separate counseling letter will be issued.
- **15.** No TA/DA will be paid for attending counseling.

Admission

- The selected candidates have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the same day or succeeding day of their admission to the course.
 Only those candidates who are found to be medically fit shall be granted admission.
- 2. The candidates who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found medically unfit shall not be allowed to join the course.
- 3. Admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with the rules/criteria mentioned in this prospectus. However, in all matters which need interpretation or for which no provision exists in the prospectus, the decision of the Admission Committee shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained regarding rejection or disqualification of any candidate.
- 4. Fees are to be paid on the day of the medical examination if the candidate is found to be medically fit. The candidature of the eligible candidates, who do not deposit the prescribed fees in full, shall stand automatically cancelled and vacancies so caused shall be offered to the candidates next in order of merit. No correspondence or appeal in this connection will be entertained by the Admission Committee.
- 5. In case the information furnished or certificates/documents submitted by the candidate are found to be fake or the candidate is found to have withheld or concealed information in the print out online application form his/her admission shall stand cancelled and the fee deposited shall be forfeited. In addition, he/she may also face legal action under the law of the land.
- 6. The original certificates of the selected candidates will be retained by the respective institution as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.
- 7. The original certificates of the selected candidates shall be returned only if the seat is surrendered in writing by the candidate, as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.
- 8. All admissions to MBBS/BDS/BHMS courses shall be provisional and subject to the approval by Panjab University, National Medical Commission /Dental Council of India/Professional regulatory bodies of the concerned courses.

9. All legal disputes relating to admission of students will be subject to courts having jurisdiction in Chandigarh.

A-3): Eligibility Criteria, General Condition and admission procedure for 115 UT Chandigarh Pool seats: (General Category, SC Category, Person with Disability Category)

In supersession of the Notification No. GMCH/TA-1(4/E)/2018/45819-27 dated 31.10.2018 and all other notifications/ instructions/ orders issued in this regard, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is pleased to amend the eligibility criteria for admission to State (UT Chandigarh) Quota Seats in MBBS course in Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh.

The following criteria shall be followed for admission to State (UT Chandigarh) Quota Seats in MBBS Course in GMCH-32, Chandigarh from the date of issuance of this notification vide No. 4486/E-134842/F-II(GMCH)/2023/10399 dated 15.07.2022: -

1. Candidates who had completed 10th, 10+1 and 10+2 from schools/ colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, as regular student of the said school/ college.

OR

2. Candidates whose parents are residents of Chandigarh for the past 05 years immediately preceding the date of application even if they do not satisfy the criteria as laid down in condition No.1 above. The requisite residence certificate issued from the office of Deputy Commissioner will be taken as proof for this purpose.

OR

3. Candidates whose parents are employees of Central Government/ State Government who are on deputation to U.T., Administration, including government employees of Chandigarh Administration/ employees working in autonomous bodies/ companies in which Chandigarh Administration has 20% or more share, for the past 03 years immediately preceding the date of application even if they do not satisfy the criteria as laid down in condition No. 1 & 2 above.

OR

4. Those candidates who are wards of serving Defence Personnel/ Ex-Servicemen having permanent address of UT Chandigarh in their service record, at the time of entry into defence services. The requisite certificate for permanent address issued by the respective Competent Authority will be taken as proof for this purpose.

However, candidates of all four categories above will have to submit an undertaking/ affidavit that the candidate has not opted and claimed benefit of residence in any other State/UT other than Chandigarh after the declaration of NEET result.

Candidates need to submit one of the following documents/certificates to establish their eligibility for UT Chandigarh Pool: -

 i. Class 10, 10+1 and 10+2 Certificate from schools/colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, as regular student of the said school/college as per Appendix A1 if eligible as per criteria 1

OR

ii. Residence Certificate to be issued by the office of the Deputy Commissioner, U.T., Chandigarh mentioning period of residence with dates as per Appendix A2 if eligible as per criteria 2

OR

iii. Certificate to be issued by the respective Head of the Department for candidates whose parents are working in Central Government/ State Government and are on deputation to Chandigarh Administration/ employees of Chandigarh Administration / working in Autonomous bodies/ companies in which Chandigarh Administration has 20% or more share for the past 03 years immediately preceding the date of application **as per Appendix A3** if eligible as per criteria 3.

OR

iv. Certificate to be issued by the respective Competent Authority in case of candidates applying in the category of wards of serving Defence Personnel/ Ex-Servicemen as per Appendix A4 if eligible as per criteria 4.

AND

Candidates of all four categories above, will have to submit an undertaking /affidavit that the candidate has not opted and claimed benefit of residence in any other State/UT other than Chandigarh after the declaration of NEET result both at the time of applying and again a fresh undertaking at the time of appearing for counseling [as per Appendix A5]

NOTE:-

i) The candidate who has applied for State Quota seats claiming residence in any other state(s) / UT(s) other than UT Chandigarh, his/her candidature will be rejected.

- ii) The candidate who has applied for State Quota/ Management Quota seats in Pvt. College/ Deemed Universities claiming residence in state(s)/ UT(s)other than UT Chandigarh, his/her candidature will be rejected.
- iii) The candidate who has applied in GMCH as well as other states and have withdrawn their candidature from other states, his/her candidature will be cancelled and will be treated as 'opted and claimed' in other states even if he/she withdraw the application after applying.
- iv) If the clarification sought from the candidate by any means viz email, phone, text message, written letter etc. is not received within stipulated period, the candidature will be cancelled.

General conditions and admission procedure

- 1. ONLY INDIAN CITIZENS are eligible to apply under the categories of UT Chandigarh Pool.
- Only those candidates whose names appear in the NEET (UG)-2023 list of successful
 candidates, prepared by NTA (National Testing Agency), will be eligible for admission in
 MBBS course.
- 3. The candidates must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English as a regular student of school/college recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the union territory of Chandigarh individually in the qualifying 12th standard examination.
- 4. A candidate must have secured following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in 12th standard examination:

General category: not less than 50%

(Including Foreign Indian Students)

Person with Disability (General Category): not less than 45%

SC category (Including SC PwD category): not less than 40%

5. The candidates must have come in the rank list prepared as a result of NEET (UG)-2023 by securing following minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio- technology taken together:

General category: not less than 50th percentile

(Including Foreign Indian Students)

Person with Disability (General Category): not less than 45th percentile SC category (Including SC PwD category): not less than 40th percentile

- 6. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of rank obtained in NEET (UG)-2023.
- Seat remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool SC (PwD) category on account of non-availability of eligible candidate shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool SC Category candidates.
- 8. Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool SC category/Person with Disability (PwD) of General category on account of non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates. In case no candidate or less number of candidates than available seats have applied in Persons with Disability category, the conversion of seat reserved for person with Disability (PwD) into General Category will take place during the Ist counseling itself.
- The original certificates of the selected candidates will be retained by the college as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.
- 10. The original certificates of the selected candidates shall be returned only if the seat is surrendered in writing by the candidate, as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.
- 11. All relevant clauses of Counseling and Admission (Page No. 11-15) will be applicable to the candidates appearing for/admitted against UT Chandigarh Pool seats.

A-4): Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats reserved for Scheduled Castes including SC PwD candidates

- 1. The candidates must fulfill relevant Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats.
- 2. Candidates must have claimed his/her eligibility for SC category while applying for NEET (UG) 2023 examination.

Certificate not bearing the seal of the competent authority will not be accepted.

Scheduled Caste Category candidates who otherwise fulfill the eligibility criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool, but submit Scheduled Caste category certificate issued by

- State / UT other than UT Chandigarh, will not be considered eligible for admission against seats reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates in UT Chandigarh Pool. Such candidates will be considered for General Category of UT Chandigarh Pool only.
- Seat remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool SC (PwD) category on account of non-availability of eligible candidate shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool SC Category candidates.
- 5. Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool SC Category on account of non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates, as per merit/rank in NEET (UG)-2023, as per reservation policy of Chandigarh Administration applicable to Medical institutions in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, notified vide letter No. 19/1/3/93/IH(3)/11138, Dated: 07.06.1995.

A-5): Eligibility criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats reserved for candidates Person with Disability (PwD)

- 5% seats in each category i.e. General, SC of UT Chandigarh Pool are reserved for PwD Candidates on Horizontal basis. Candidate selected will be placed in appropriate category i.e. SC (PwD) candidate in SC (PwD) category and General Candidate in General (PwD) category.
- 2. The candidates must fulfill relevant Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats.
- 3. Candidate must have claimed his/her eligibility for PwD category while applying for NEET (UG) 2023 examination.
- 4. Only Disability Certificate issued by designated centers approved by National Medical Commission will be accepted. List of centers approved for issuing of disability certificates is attached at **Appendix D**.
- Admission will be made strictly on the basis of rank obtained in NEET (UG)-2023 for PwD category.
- Seat remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool SC (PwD) category on account of non-availability of eligible candidate shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool SC Category candidates.
- Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from PwD General Category of UT Chandigarh Pool, on account of non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates as per merit/rank in NEET (UG)-2023.

A-6): Eligibility criteria and admission procedure for Foreign Indian Student:

- 1. <u>The Candidates must be of Indian origin</u>. These seats are not open to foreign nationals who are of non-Indian origin.
- Candidates must have claimed his/her eligibility for NRI/OCI category while applyingfor NEET (UG) – 2023 examination.
- 3. The candidates meeting any of the following criteria will be eligible to apply for admission under this category:
 - a. Persons of Indian origin who are citizens of countries other than India and hold the passport of the country concerned.
 - b. Overseas Citizens of India.

Explanation:

c. Indian citizens (candidates) who have resided in a country other than India for a minimum period of three years immediately preceding the year of admission in the Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh.

The aforesaid condition of residence for a minimum period of three years in a country other than India prescribed in clause (iii) above means actual/ physical residence on a regular basis. Notional, Deemed or constructive residence of any kind shall not be considered for this purpose. Accordingly, possession of a Green card/Permanent Resident Permit will ipso facto not confer eligibility or entitlement for admission. For compliance with this clause, the candidate should submit the certificates from the school(s) attended in a country other than India during the three years immediately preceding the year of admission as a regular student i.e., full session of Class 10 in 2020-2021, Class 11 in 2021-2022 and Class 12 in 2022-2023. If the candidate has a gap between the Class 12 examination and the present admission year 2023 i.e. passed Class 12 in 2022 or earlier, then the candidate must provide proof of actual residence abroad for three years immediately preceding the year of admission, in the form of a certificate issued from the Indian embassy/Consulate in that country that the candidate was residing in the concerned country (Foreign country) from 2020-2023 (covering an actual period of 3 years)

 The expression "Overseas Citizens of India" in clauses (ii) above refers to persons registered as such under <u>Section 7-A of the</u> <u>Citizenship Act, 1955 as amended up-to-date.</u>

Code 07: Any other examination which in scope and standard (Last 02 years of 10+2 Study comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology; which shall include practical test in these subjects) is found to be equivalent to the Intermediate Science Examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology including practical tests in each of these subjects and English.

Provided further that the students who have received education abroad and wish to seek admission into medical colleges in India must have passed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English with 50% marks in Class 12 and their equivalency determined by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as per regulations of the National Medical Commission AND the concerned University [i.e. Panjab University, Chandigarh].

- 6. The candidate must provide the certificate of 10+2/pre-medical/of 10+2+3 system qualifying examination from any university/board showing detailed marks/explanation sheets of grade. The candidates must provide the percentage marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology as well as English of both Class10+1 and 10+2 level.
- 7. Foreign Indian Student candidates who have passed 10+2 from CBSE/PSEB/HPSE/HSEB or any other Board/University of India, need not obtain eligibility and equivalence certificate from AIU or the Panjab University, Chandigarh.
- 8. Admission to Foreign Indian Student category seats will be conducted in accordance with the instructions/guidelines issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time. These candidates will be divided into two categories which are as follows:

Category-I: This category includes **Foreign Indian Student** candidates with <u>ancestral background of Chandigarh</u>. To be eligible for this category candidate should fulfill one of the following criteria:

- II. Own/owned immovable property in the name of grandparents/ parents/ self in Chandigarh for at least 5 years at any time since the origin of Chandigarh. A certificate to the effect of either of the above mentioned criteria is required from the office of the Deputy Commissioner, U.T., Chandigarh.

Category-II: This category includes Foreign Indian Student candidates who have ancestral background of States/UTs other than UT Chandigarh.

A certificate to this effect from competent Government authority i.e. office of the Deputy Commissioner from the district of that State or Union Territory or OCI Card has to be submitted. **Any other proof of ancestral background will NOT be accepted**.

- 9. First preference will be given to Category-I candidates
- 10. If sufficient number of candidates under Category-I are eligible and available, then they will be admitted first even if candidates under Category-II are higher in merit.
- 11. In case a seat under the Foreign Indian Student category remains vacant, the same shall be filled from UT Chandigarh Pool General category candidates as per merit/rank in NEET (UG)-2023.
- 12. All relevant clauses of **Counseling** and **Admission** (**Page No.11-15**) will be applicable to **Foreign Indian Student** category candidates.

A-7): Eligibility criteria and admission procedure for Central Pool seats:

- 1. These seats for MBBS Course will be filled up on the basis of recommendations of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
- 2. Eligible candidates should **not** apply directly for these seats to Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh.
- 3. The candidates must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology & English individually in the qualifying 12th standard examination.
- 4. A candidate must have secured following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination:

General category: not less than 50%

(Including NRI/Foreign Indian Students)

Person with Disability (General Category): not less than 45%

SC category (Including SC PwD category): not less than 40%

5. The candidates nominated by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, who have not passed their 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination from Indian University/Board will have to obtain the eligibility and

equivalence certificates for the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 examinations of PSEB/CBSE/ICSE) from Panjab University, Chandigarh AND NMC designated authority (AIU or other).

6. The candidate must have secured following minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology taken together in the NEET (UG)-2023 examination: General category:

(Including NRI/Foreign Indian Students)

- Only candidates whose names appear in the NEET (UG)-2023 merit list of successful candidates prepared by NTA (National Testing Agency) for BDS will be eligible to apply. This condition is also applicable to NRI Category candidates.
- 3. A candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology & English individually in the qualifying 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination.
- 4. A candidate must have secured following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination:

General category:

not less than 50%

(Including candidates from Hoshiarpur District, preferably of Jaj (Judge Community)/ NRI/Foreign National

SC/ST/ Backward Class (BC) category:

not less than 40%

Person with Disability (PwD: *In respect of candidates with locomotor disability of lower limbs, the minimum of 45% marks for Gen-PwD and 40% marks for SC-PwD are required*).

Important Note:- Candidates passing 12th Standard examination from recognized board by Central/ State Government only, are eligible for admission.

5. A candidate appearing/appeared in the qualifying 12th Standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination in 2023 where result is awaited can also apply. However, he/she shall not be eligible for admission, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required pass percentage of marks prior to the first round of Counseling. He/she will be allowed to attend first counseling, only if detailed marks certificate of the above said examination is submitted prior to or at the time of first counseling, failing which he/she will be declared ineligible for admission in academic session starting in year 2023 and his/her application will be rejected.

6. The candidates must have secured following minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Bio-technology taken together in the NEET (UG)-2023 for BDS General category:
not less than 50th percentile

(Including candidates from Hoshiarpur District, preferably of Jaj (Judge Community)/ NRI/Foreign National

SC/ST/ Backward Class (BC) category: not less than 40th percentile

Person with Disability (PwD: *In respect of candidates with locomotor disability of lower limbs, the minimum of 45th percentile for Gen-PwD and 40th percentile for SC-PwD are required).*

- 7. All eligible candidates including own merit candidates from reserved categories (except PwD/Foreign Indian Student /International/NRI category candidates), will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list, in addition to the category/categories they have applied for.
- 8. Candidate(s) belonging to a reserved category who fulfills all the criteria for general category (own merit candidates) and on the basis of his/her rank/merit in the NEET (UG)-2023 obtains admission in general category shall not be counted towards the seats earmarked for the reserved category concerned.
- Original certificates/documents will have to be deposited by the candidate at the time of counseling, after the seat has been allotted to the candidate. The certificates/documents shall be returned to the candidate only after surrendering the seat.
- 10. In case any candidate surrenders a seat, he/she will not be eligible to attend subsequent admission counselings for the BDS course.

B-4): Eligibility Criteria for International / NRI Students

Only NEET (UG)-2023 qualified (not less than 50th percentile) candidates can apply for admission against NRI Category seats for admission year 2023.

A foreign national may seek admission in BDS being offered by the University through the International Students Office under any of the following categories-

- (i) Candidates with nomination / sponsorship by any foreign State, Embassy or authority in India under a Study in India / Exchange Programme, etc.
- (ii) Foreign nationals or their wards who are self-financed students (not seeking admission through a mode as mentioned in (i) above).

(iii) Non- resident Indians or their Wards (not seeking admission through a mode as mentioned in (i) above).

The definition of the terms, "Foreign Nationals, Non-resident Indians and Wards" be considered as under: -

- 1. Foreign Nationals: Foreign Nationals holding passports issued by foreign countries including people of Indian origin who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries are included as foreign students. Provided any subsequent changes in the definition as may be notified by the Government of India shall have the same latest meaning respectively assigned to them. The other expressions not defined herein shall have the meaning as may be assigned in any subsequent notification of the Government of India.
- 2. Non-resident Indians: A person shall be deemed to be Non-resident Indian for seeking admission in Panjab University if he/she fulfils the criterion (as amended from time to time) for status of NRI under Income Tax Act, 1961, in the year in which he/she seeks admission in Panjab University.

As per Income Tax Act, 1961 the present criterion for determination of status of NRI is as follows: -

'Non-resident Indian' is an individual who is a citizen of India or a person of Indian origin and who is not a resident of India. Thus, in order to determine whether an Individual is a non-resident Indian or not, his residential status is required to be determined under Section 6. As per Section 6 of the Incometax Act, an individual is said to be non-resident in India if he is not a resident in India and an individual is deemed to be resident in India in any previous year if he satisfies any of the following conditions: -

(i) If he/she/others is in India for a period of 182 days or more during the previous year;

or

(ii) If he/she/others is in India for a period of 60 days or more during the previous year and 365 days or more during 4 years immediately preceding the previous year.

However, condition No. (ii) does not apply where an individual being citizen of India or a person of Indian origin, who being outside India, comes on a visit to India during the previous year.

A person shall be deemed to be of Indian origin if he, or either of his parents or any of his parents or any of his grand – parents, was born in undivided India.

3. Wards of Foreign Nationals and NRIs:

A student who seeks admission as a ward of Foreign National or Non-resident Indian should be in a first degree / blood relationship with foreign national or Non-resident Indian. The term first degree / blood relationship includes

- (a) spouse
- (b) children (natural / adopted / foster)
- (c) real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt
- (d) real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt
- (e) father and mother of father i.e. grand father and grand-mother
- (f) Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grand-father and maternal grand-mother
- (g) first degree-paternal and maternal cousins.

Following documents are to be attached with the application:

- a. Affidavits and undertaking (Appendix J-I/II/III)
- b. Photocopy of sponsor Passport

Eligibility and Admission Criterion:

- (i) The students who will be admitted against the NRI quota should have the basic qualification fixed by the Dental Council of India for admission in Dental courses.
- (ii) A candidate once admitted as NRI candidate in an undergraduate course shall be covered under the definition of NRI for subsequent admission to any course at Panjab University.
- (iii) Candidates who take admission under the NRI quota and are promoted from Undergraduate to Postgraduate course in the Hons. School framework (ongoing program) shall not be allowed to change their category.
- (iv) NRI candidates shall have to comply with any other requirements prescribed by the Govt. of India and Panjab University from time to time.
- (v) The Foreign Nationals and NRI candidates shall provide the following certificates / documents: -
- (a) The Foreign National and NRI students wishing to join BDS course of the Panjab University for the first time are required to obtain an eligibility certificate from the *Deputy Registrar (General)*, *Panjab University*, *Chandigarh* or Academic Certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent

- examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/ Commonwealth Universities/International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/ Certificates.
- (b) The foreign students admitted are required to fill up Foreign Student Information System (FSIS) Form complete in all respects, along with copies of passport and Visa and submit to the office of Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh. This form is an urgent requirement of the Foreign Registration Office (FRO), Sector-9, Chandigarh and the candidate has to report to the Foreign Registration Office (FRO) within fourteen days of arrival in Chandigarh, with the number generated after the online submission of this form. Foreign Students Information System (FSIS) is to be submitted by hand by the candidate and the FSIS No. will be issued by this Office personally to the students.
- (c) Foreign Students Welfare Fee @ Rs.1500/- per student. Each NRI/Foreign Student is required to submit the same in cash, which may be deposited with the 'Extension Counter, State Bank of India, Administrative Block, Panjab University, Chandigarh. Original Receipts of the fee deposited is to be submitted to the office of the Dean International Students along with Registration Form (To be submitted after Confirmation of Admission)

B-5): Inter-Changeability and Transfer of Seats during Second Counseling.

- In the SC/ST reserved category the seats shall be regarded as 'interchangeable'. That is to say, if a sufficient number of eligible candidates are not available to fill up the seats reserved for Scheduled Tribes, seats may be filled up from among the eligible candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, and vice-versa.
- Seat remaining unfilled from SC (PwD) category on account of nonavailability of eligible candidate shall be filled from eligible SC Category candidates.
- 3. In case sufficient number of eligible candidates, belonging to reserved categories (SC/ST/BC/Person with Disability (PwD General Category), Hoshiarpur District, preferably Jaj (Judge) community / International / NRI Students /Central Pool) are not available, the vacant seats shall be transferred to General Category of All India Pool.

B-6) Medical Examination:-

- All admitted candidates will have to undergo medical examination by the Medical Board of the Dr. Harvansh Singh Judge Institute of Dental Sciences & Hospital, Panjab University, Sector 25, Chandigarh. The admission of those candidates who do not appear before Medical Board or are found to be medically unfit is liable to be cancelled.

NRI candidate fee shall be payable in the form of Bank Draft in US dollar/ Pounds, Sterling/ Deutschmark or equivalent amount in Indian Currency payable to the "REGISTRAR, PANJAB UNIVERSITY, CHANDIGARH" (payable at Chandigarh) ALONG WITH A BANK CERTIFICATE FOR ENCASHMENT OF FOREIGN CURRENCY OF THE LIKE AMOUNT.

THE FEE TO BE CHARGED IS SUBJECT TO REVISION AND AMENDMENT FROM TIME TO TIME AND THE REVISED DECISION WILL BE APPLICABLE IRRESPECTIVE OF THAT GIVEN IN THIS PROSPECTUS.

3. Admitted students will be required to pay full fee (as due) at the time of admission.

- 4. The candidates will have to pay the exact amount as per Panjab University fee structure prevailing at the time of admission. The amount mentioned above is approximate.

- In case of (1) in the table above, the HE1 concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 10% of the aggregate fees as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- 2. Fee shall be refunded by the all HEIs to an eligible student within fifteen days

from the date of receiving a written application from him / her in this regard.

- 3. Refund forms will be available at the P.U. Website i.e. http://forms.puchd.ac.in (the photocopy of bank passbook of the candidate only be attached)
- 4. But in all other Cases of the students continuing their studies, the Library Security will be refunded if he/she will apply within six months from the date of leaving the Department/Institute/Centre/Regional Centre after completing the full course of studies.

II. Refund of Fee Rules of NRI Category and Foreign Nationals

In case, the candidate is admitted in the Foreign/NRI category and leaves the course & the seat vacated by a candidate is filled by granting admission to another applicant against the vacated seat, the tuition fee may be refunded to the person after deduction of 10% of the tuition fee as administrative charges. In case a seat vacated by such a candidate is not filled, the tuition fee may be refunded after deduction of 25% of the tuition fee as administrative charges. This will be applicable only in the case where the candidate has left the University Department/Institute/ Centre/ Regional Centre & did not join any other course in the Panjab University. All other funds and charges including Development Fund, in no case, shall be refunded. For this purpose, he/she must apply for refund on the prescribed refund application form through the Head of the Department to the Assistant Registrar Accounts-II. That the time period for applying refund of fee by the students be fixed up to 30th November. However, all other funds & charges including development fund, shall not be refunded under any circumstances, except refundable Library Security.

B-9): Cancellation of Admission

Admission of all such students who fail to attend at least 33% of the total lectures/tutorials/practicals etc. delivered/held in all the papers during the first ten working days from the start of teaching work shall be cancelled by the Board of Control/Joint Admission Cell after following the procedure given below:

a) By the 12th day after the start of classes for a particular course, the names of those students who fail to attend at least 33% of the total lectures / tutorials / practicals etc. shall be put up on the Notice Board and online Notice Board of the Institute and also send a copy of the same to the office of the DUI. Within 4 days of the date of such notice, a student who is short

- of attendance may give in writing the reasons for his absence from the classes.
- b) If a student does not submit an application in writing within the prescribed time as stated above, or the reasons adduced by the student in his application are not found to be sufficient and justified in the opinion of the Board of Control/Joint Admission Cell, his admission shall be cancelled.
- c) All the seats thus falling vacant shall be filled strictly in the order of merit from the waiting list or through subsequent counseling before the expiry of the last date fixed for admissions by the University.
- d) When the admission of the student(s) is cancelled as stated above, the Institute shall display on the Notice Board and online Notice Board, the list of the person(s) next in the waiting list and make admissions accordingly.
- e) The cancellation of admission and permission to fill up the cancelled seat(s) shall be done in accordance with the Rules & Regulations provided in the Handbook of Information 2023.

B-10 Discharge from the BDS course:

f) As per Dental Council of India (DCI) Notification No. DE-87(1)-2015 dated 27.04.2015 and passed in Senate of Panjab University vide para R-55 dated 27.09.2015:

"Any Student who does not clear the BDS course in all the subjects within a period of 9 years, including one year Compulsory Rotatory paid Internship from the date of admission shall be discharged from the course. This is effective from the academic session i.e. 2015-16 onwards".
