UGNEET- UGCET - 2024 – First Round ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS – DEPOSITION / SUBMISSION

- Seats have been allotted based on the information entered in the online application by fetching the data wherever it is applicable.
- After publication of first round final real seat allotment result candidates have to submit originals in the required format as per rules / norms to take the admission.
- Original documents required for each eligibility clause is defined in the UGCET-2024 and UGNEET – 2024 Information Bulletin hosted on the KEA Website.
- Seat allotted to the candidate will be withdrawn immediately in case if a candidate fails to submit the required original documents and such seats will be taken back to seat pool and will be offered in the subsequent round to another eligible candidate.
- All candidates are informed to be ready with required original documents / certificates as per the required format and no excuses will be accepted for non-submission of original documents.
- Before admitting the candidates, college authorities should verify the eligibility criteria and documents as per "Verification Slip" and should collect all the original documents.

Caution on Deposition of original documents by the candidates:

- After verification during or after deposition of original documents, if any documents uploaded
 are not matching with the original documents, seat will be cancelled at any stage during the
 course of study without any further notice.
- If it is found that the Candidate has produced fake, fraudulent certificates, forged documents, he/she will be liable for criminal prosecution in accordance with law & immediate loss of allotted seat without any notice whatsoever, & forfeiture of fees.
- Further the Government of Karnataka, the Karnataka Examinations Authority / Directorate of Medical Education / Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences / Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belgavi / Directorate of Technical Education reserves the right to cause any verification as deemed essential at any point of time.
- If on such verification it is found that the Candidate has produced fake, fraudulent certificates, he/she will be liable for criminal prosecution, immediate loss of allotted seat without any notice whatsoever, recovery of monetary compensation as may be decided by competent authority, & will be liable to be debarred from all exams in future. Government may also recommend blacklisting of the Candidate to AICTE / NEET / NMC / MCC / DCI / KMC and cancellation of candidature.
