**NOTICE NO.05**

**CLARIFICATION ABOUT SEAT MATRIX**

We have received some mails from candidates regarding Seat Matrix in respect of NEET UG published on website. With regards to same we would like to inform that the seat matrix is prepared as per the policy decided by State of Maharashtra.

- 1) **10 % seats are calculated based on all state quota seats, without excluding institutional quota seats.**
  - It is informed that it is based on the provision in clause 5 (a) of the SEBC Act, 2024.
- 2) **In case of private institutes, the proportion of seats allotted to their respective quotas is less.**
  - The reservation quota is applied as per Annexure B of the Information Brochure.
- 3) **SEBC seats earmarked in minority Institutes**
  - This mistake is rectified. Revised provisional seat matrix is uploaded on website on 29/08/2024.
- 4) **No provision for EWS reservation in private institutes :- The provision of 9.4.1.**
  - As per 9.4.1 of the Information Brochure,
  - **"EWS reservation:10% seats of the available seats will be reserved for EWS candidates. For MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS and BUMS courses, this reservation will be applicable only if central Government / respective council increased existing seats. For courses other than MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BHMS and BUMS courses 10% EWS reservation will be applicable on available seats"**
