UGNEET – MEDICAL / DENTAL / AYUSH COURSES  
PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED BY A CANDIADTES AFTER PUBLICATION OF SECOND ROUND  
SEAT ALLOTMENT RESULTS

1. As already well informed, there will not be any CHOICES available to the candidates who have been allotted seat in UGNEET-2024 second round seat allotment, they have to pay the fees (if not paid earlier) by following the procedures for fee payment (deposition of original documents to medical seat allotted candidates – please read the instructions) and download the admission order and report to the allotted college. Fee paid in the previous round if any, towards medical, dental or for AYUSH courses will be adjusted for the seat allotted in this round.
2. Caution Deposit paid for medical seat will be adjusted against medical seat allotted in the second round. Caution deposit will be returned to the candidates if medical seat is not allotted in the second round. Caution deposit will not be adjusted for allotment of seat to any other courses.
3. Candidates who have been allotted Government Medical seat in Private Medical Colleges and Private Medical seat in Private Medical colleges, deposit the original documents (if not submitted) at KEA, Bangalore, with two sets of attested photocopies as per their eligibility. (As per the schedule)
4. Candidates who have been allotted Medical seat in Government Medical Colleges and allotted Medical seat under NRI / Others quota in Private Medical Colleges **NEED NOT** submit the **originals at KEA, Bangalore**, but they must compulsorily submit the original documents at the respective colleges at the time of admission.
5. If a candidate is not interested in the allotted Medical seat, can cancel the allotted medical seat in person at **KEA, Bangalore** before **5.30 pm on 25-09-2024**. **Caution Deposit amount will be forfeited.**
6. If a candidate is not interested in the allotted Dental / AYUSH seat, can cancel the allotted Dental / AYUSH seat in person at **KEA, Bangalore** by paying Rs.10,000/- penalty before **5.30 pm on 25-09-2024**. (DD has to be submitted drawn in f/o Executive Director, KEA – payable at Bangalore – if no payment available in KEA)
7. After cancellation as per 5-6 above, candidates will be allowed to participate in the online Mop-Up round. **Chances of getting the newly added option in the online mop-up round is subject to availability of seats. As the other candidates next to your rank might have entered those options and seat would have been allotted to them based on merit.**
8. Candidates who fail to surrender or not join the allotted college will have to pay one year fees and Rs.10,000/-.
